HOME INSPECTION REPORT SUMMARY

ABOUT THE HOME

This well-built approximately 90-year-old semi-detached home (with a basement apartment) has had many renovations & upgrades performed on all three levels and is in very good condition overall inside & out.

- **Roofing** The newer asphalt shingles are above average quality and can last 20+ years. The shared rear chimney is used for the water heater only by this semi: some repairs were noted.
- **Exterior** It has been well maintained and the bricks/metal-siding are in good condition. Several components have been updated: ie. The doors & most windows have been replaced. Extensive damp-proofing/weeping tile replacement has been done.
- Structure The solid masonry & wood structure with concrete block foundation has performed well. A newer wood/drywall party wall was noted in the attic: this is very desirable.
- **Electrical** There is an upgraded 100amp entry/breaker-panel. Ground/arc fault interrupters were noted. The sellers had all the knob & tube wiring replaced when they took possession in 2020.
- **Heating** The 7-year-old gas-fired high-efficiency furnace can typically last up to 20 years. This will help save energy costs.
- Cooling The 7-year-old a/c can typically last up to 15 yrs.
- **Insulation** The large attic structure and the rafters-deckboards are aging well. There is an upgraded amount of insulation.
- Plumbing The visible supply plumbing in the home is copper including
 the upgraded main water service line. Some waste pipe improvements
 were noted. The kitchen & 2nd floor bathroom have been redone to very
 good standards.
- Interior Very good quality interior finishes were noted throughout the home, and it has been well taken care of with obvious signs there is a high degree of pride of ownership. The basement has been finished as an apartment with a 3-piece bathroom, kitchen, front bedroom area, storage closet, etc.
